


Prophecies Concerning Jesus and Their Fulfilment

PSA 69:4: <i>"They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head: they that would destroy me, being mine enemies wrongfully, are mighty: then I restored that which I took not away."</i> (PSA 109:3-5)	Was Hated Without a Cause	JN 15:23-25: <i>"He that hateth me hateth my Father also. If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father. But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause."</i>
ISA 53:4,5: <i>"Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. PSA 22:6-8: <i>"But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people.
